Summit Life Outreach Center's First Annual Fundraiser Welcomes Father Pavone!!!

All praise, honor and glory be to God Almighty! We are blessed with people who truly love their neighbor! On October 13, 2007 at the Fatima Shrine in Lewiston, NY, the Summit Life Outreach Center held its first annual banquet. Alive with enthusiasm for the success of our new pregnancy outreach center, 314 pro-life supporters eagerly awaited our guest speaker, Fr. Frank A. Pavone, an avid defender of the priceless dignity of every human life.

In his inspiring discourse, Fr. Pavone highlighted the unique role [in protecting pre-born lives](#) played by all people born after the 1973 Roe v Wade decision. Pro-abortion advocates have silenced more than 48 million voices since that date. Fr. Pavone spoke of a message of hope, that the young people of this country will be “strong voices in the fight to save the lives of pre-born babies.” They have a particularly poignant “sense of personal loss, of being survivors...” as they realize that they have “lost brothers, sisters, cousins, spouses, classmates.” They understand that the definition (per Roe v Wade) of “person” entitled to “life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness” did not pertain to them. They understand that the aborted child “could’ve been me.” Young people are demanding that their voices be heard because “they were a person when they were in their mother’s womb, they were a person after they were born and they are a person today.”



Fr. Pavone very smartly distinguishes the pro-abortion message of “exclusion” from the pro-life message of “inclusion” when defining a “person” who is entitled to rights as defined by our nation’s Constitution. He calls us all to be more vigilant, [now more than ever](#), in this war to save children. Those who have been injured by abortion refuse to be silenced any longer. He said, “men and women who have lost a child to abortion are speaking up [\(now\) more than ever.](#)” “[Not a single benefit has been brought to the world](#)” by abortion but “[medical science’s newest patient is the child in the womb.](#)” He said that abortion facilities “can’t maintain their staff, not because medical students and doctors fear for their lives but because they don’t want to use their skills to take human life.” With deeply moving words, Fr. Pavone declared the promise he offers every frightened pregnant mother: “When you know what’s right and you feel the pressure to do what’s wrong, take my hand and let me show you there’s another way. I will show you that you’re not alone and that we’ll stand with you.”

A warm “THANK YOU” is extended to the numerous people who made this incredible event possible. [Special thanks to James Anthony for his generosity and the love of children that motivates him to save babies’ lives, to Fr. Pavone for his passion and clarity of vision regarding the protection of pre-born children, the Banquet Committee who expended considerable time and talent in organizing this event, Joe Mombrea who filmed our center, musical contribution from David Mombrea and Eddie Simon, Rev. Peter Calabrese for his delightful introductions to speakers, Rev. Julio Ciavaglia who unhesitatingly welcomed this event into Our Lady’s Shrine, to the Barnabite Fathers who opened their doors to us, to all those who attended, all those who contributed baskets for the Chinese auction and the numerous benefactors, without](#)

whose charity, this could not have been made possible. Thank you for caring about the littlest members of our society and their families.

Question and Answer Corner



Question:

A woman tells you she's thinking about having an abortion. What should you do?

Answer:

First of all, **listen**. She's concerned about a lot of issues surrounding her pregnancy, some more than others. **Get the whole story**. Ask her questions to clarify for her why she feels the way she does and understand what is affecting her situation. **Don't be judgmental**. Her circumstances are unique to her and only she knows how she really feels. She will be the person making all of the decisions regarding her pregnancy. **Be supportive and encouraging**. Help her understand that she has the ability to make good; informed decisions and that she can take time to figure things out. **Help her think things through**. Let her picture the situations she could face based on the decisions she makes. Help her think of how to react to the scenarios she creates. Help her **contact organizations** that can assist her (and her baby) in her emotional, psychological, financial, physical, social, and spiritual needs. Finally, let her know that the conversation is **confidential**; that she can **trust** you and that you will be there for her.

- c) Once a PayPal account is established, review your payment information and press "Pay".
